



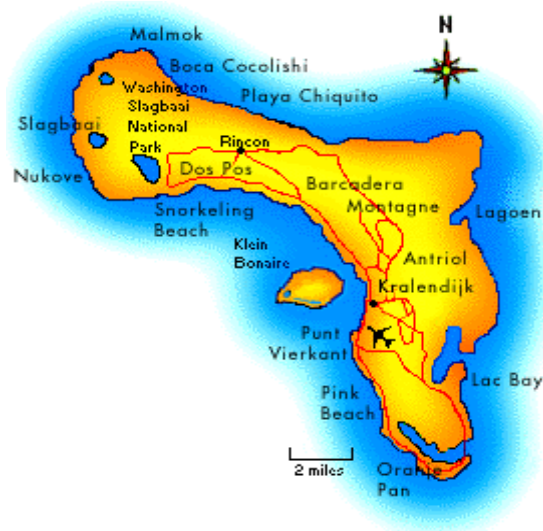
"Your Pre-Dive Safety Stop"

Bonaire, Netherlands Antilles

Bonaire's pristine reefs and diverse marine life are unique to the Caribbean. The waters around Bonaire are designated as an official marine park, diving Bonaire is like diving the Caribbean the way it used to be - untouched and unspoiled. The island's location in the south Caribbean gives it an arid climate with little rainfall; consequently, the waters are exceptionally clear of silt, calm, and diveable year round. It is definitely an ideal destination for underwater photographers! Water temperatures average a warm 78-84°F (25.6-28.9°C), with visibility often averaging over 100 feet(30m), and frequently, up to 150 feet (55m).

We will be staying at Buddy Dive Resort. This resort is an unhurried, unspoiled natural paradise offering spectacular sunsets, gentle breezes and crystal-clear, turquoise waters. Buddy's is a resort where you can dive, take part in a multitude of other activities or just sit back, relax and enjoy the atmosphere. The resort offers many amenities including 2 swimming pools, a full service dive shop, 2 restaurants and an on-site fleet of pick-up trucks. Buddy Dive's drive-through air fill station and unlimited air fills make it possible to get a lot of dives during your vacation!



Trip Includes: Roundtrip airfare from MSP to Bonaire, 8 days - 7 nights accommodations in a fully equipped 1 bedroom apartment, airport transfers, 7 days rental vehicle (double cabin pick-up truck or van – insurance included), 6 days of unlimited shore diving **plus** 6 boat dives, unlimited Nitrox, and breakfast daily.
